- 3) Do not throw any plastics or papers here and there in the ashram.
- 4) Do not throw used sanitary napkins in Toilet Commode. Throw them in general dustbins, after properly wrapping in plastic waste bag.
- 5) Bringing packaged food items, sweets, Namkeens, salty foods, noodles etc are strictly prohibited in ashram.
- 6) Save electricity and water in Ashram. Switch off lights and fans of your room when you are not in the room. Do not bring electrical kettle, electrical instruments with you.
- 7) Do not damage flowers, plants and trees in Ashram. Maintain harmony with nature.
- 8) Taking photographs inside any of the halls and Shambhala are strictly prohibited.
- 9) Photographs taken in Ashram is for your sweet memory, do not upload on public domain or media.
- 10) Do not take any utensils from kitchen or dinning area to your room.
- 11) Do not give any instructions to staff members for food preparation.
- 12) In case of any emergency/ complain/ suggestion, please contact senior trainer present there or any of the volunteers or Ashram Manager immediately to help you out.
- 13) As Ashram is an open place, you may find some insects or pets or peacocks roaming around. Please do not injure them, let them pass away and try to harmonize with other kingdoms of nature.
- 14) Please do not stay in room during the session timings. Try to be with the group and take maximum benefit of your visit.
- 15) Please bring items for your daily needs like soap, shampoo, towel, seasonal clothing etc. Do not leave their wrappers / bottles in bathrooms after usage.
